Parent Engagement

Parental engagement is when parents and school staff work together to support and improve a child's education. We encourage parents and families to actively become involved in their child's learning both at school and at home.

We strongly believe that parents are the child's first teachers. Throughout the year, parents and families will be expected to participate in several family engagement activities that will include literacy nights, math nights, home visits, parent-teacher conferences, family field trips, and more.



Student Meals

Both Cuba Pre-K and Ojo Pre-K programs will provide children with a nutritious meal for breakfast and lunch. Both programs believe that this is a perfect learning opportunity. During mealtimes, children will learn skills that include healthy eating habits, socializing with peers, self-help skills, and how to serve themselves.

Developmental Screenings

Cuba Pre-K and Ojo Pre-K programs provide inclusive settings to accommodate all children's needs. All Pre-K staff are highly qualified in conducting developmental screenings for all Pre-K children during the first 3 months of attendance.

The child's dominant language will be used during screenings. Parents will be in included in the screening process and informed of all results. If needed, referrals can be made for further assessments from the special education department to address all identified concerns.

Health Screenings

Cuba Pre-K and Ojo Pre-K programs require the following health screenings before the child can begin in the program:

- physical examination
- current immunization records
- · dental screening
- vision screening (school provides this)
- hearing screening (school provides this)

Parents have the option to use their own health provider for these screenings. Parents are notified about any referrals or other identified health concerns that need to be addressed.
