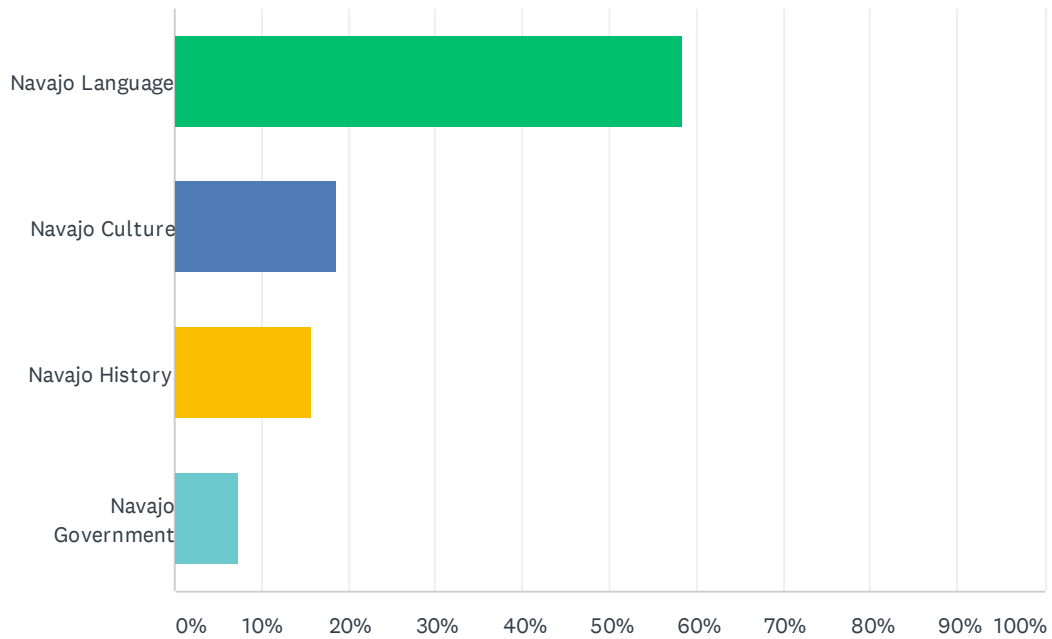


# Q1 Which of the following subjects do you consider most important for your child?

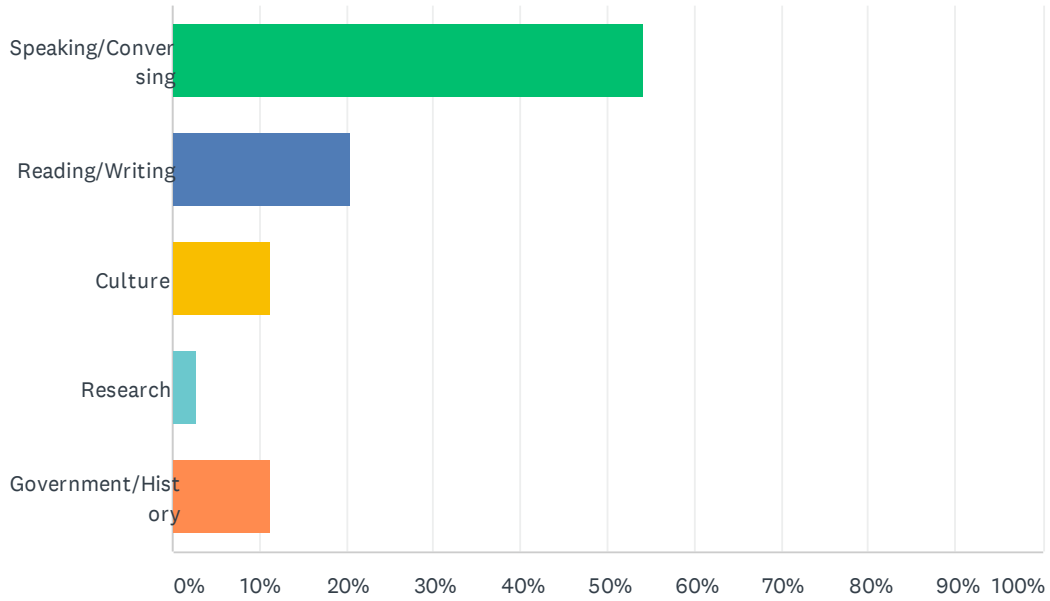

## Q2 What aspect of Navajo language class do you feel is most important?

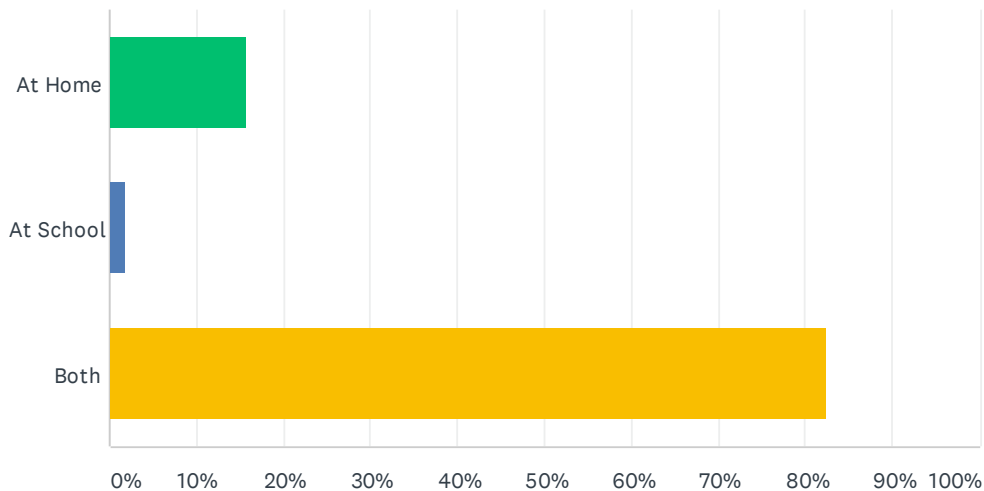

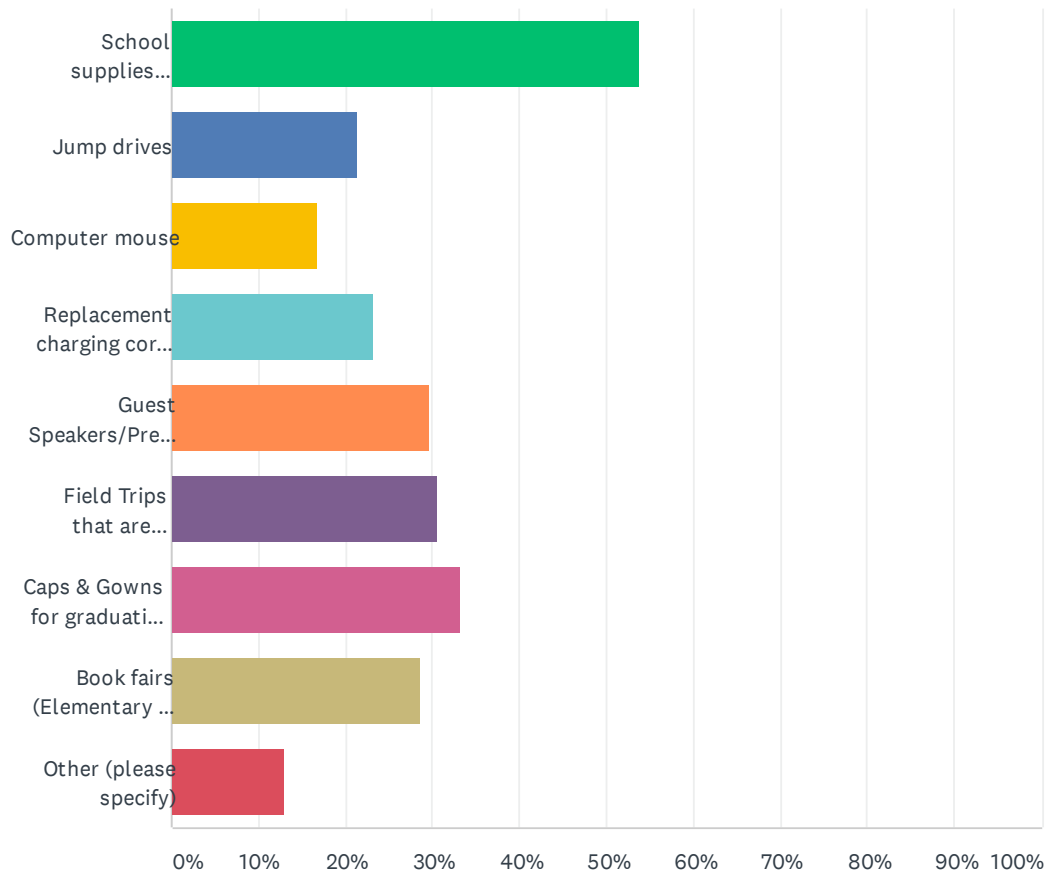

### Q4 A portion of Johnson O'Malley funds are reserved for our students. What do you feel our students are most in need of? (Please choose 2)

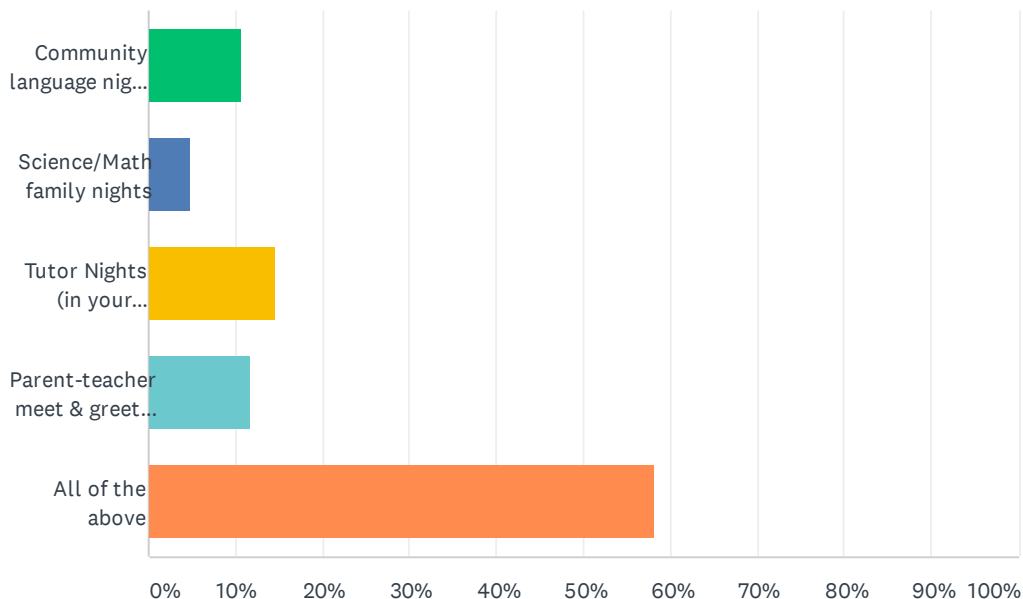

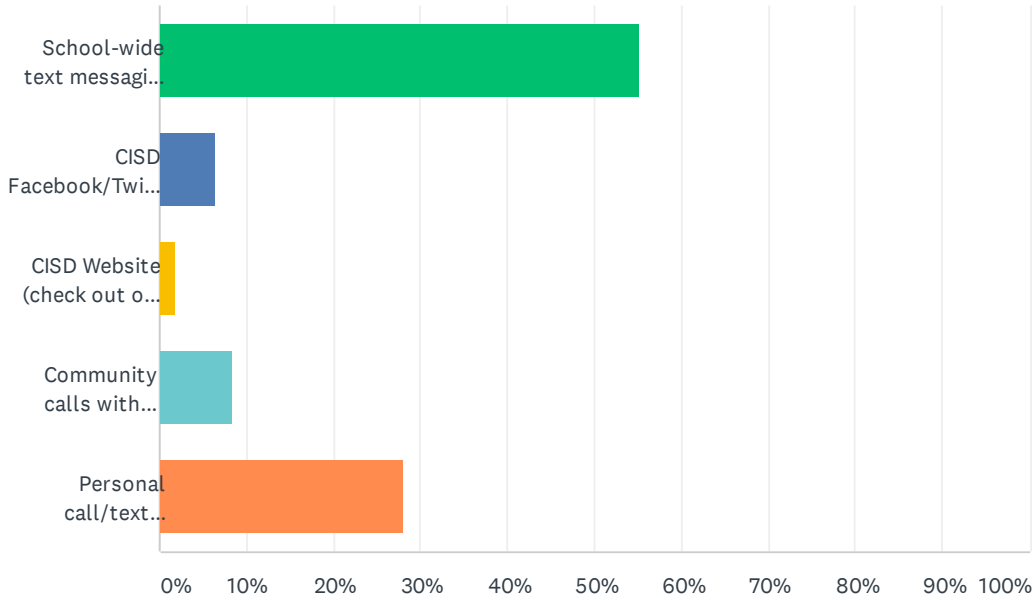

## Q6 We value parent/community involvement but often have trouble reaching our CISD family. Which of the following modes of communication works best for you?

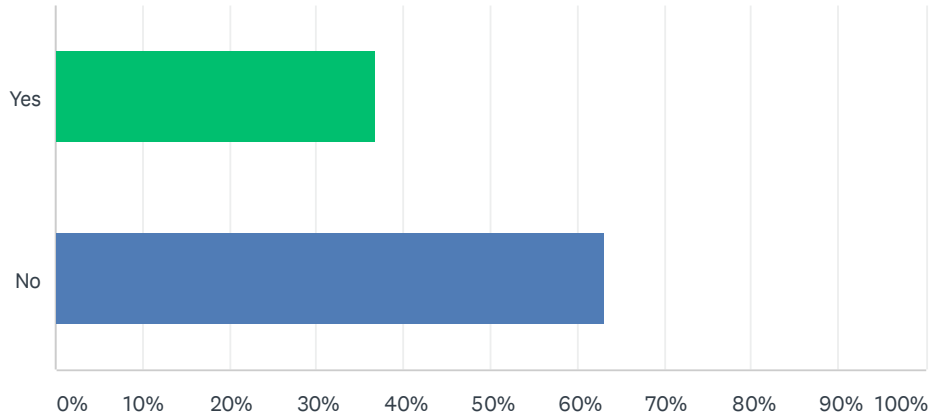

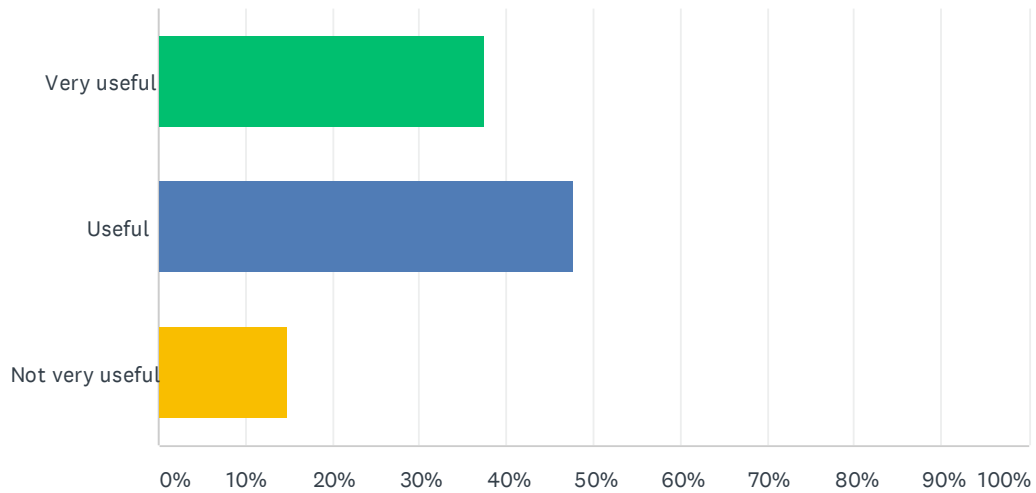

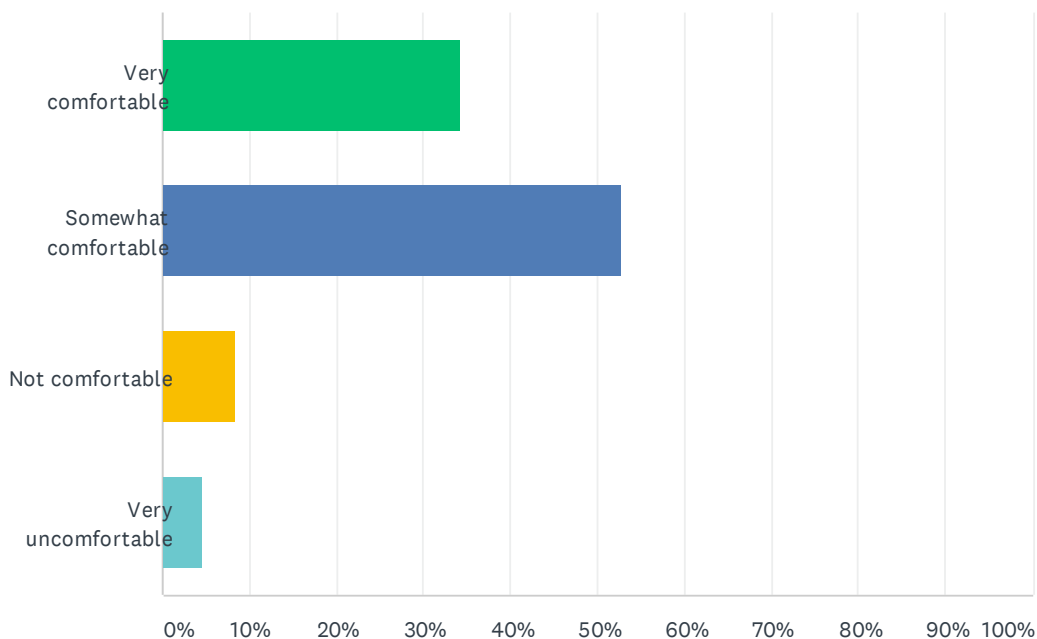

## Q9 Do you feel comfortable approaching CISD staff with any questions/concerns you have regarding your child's education?

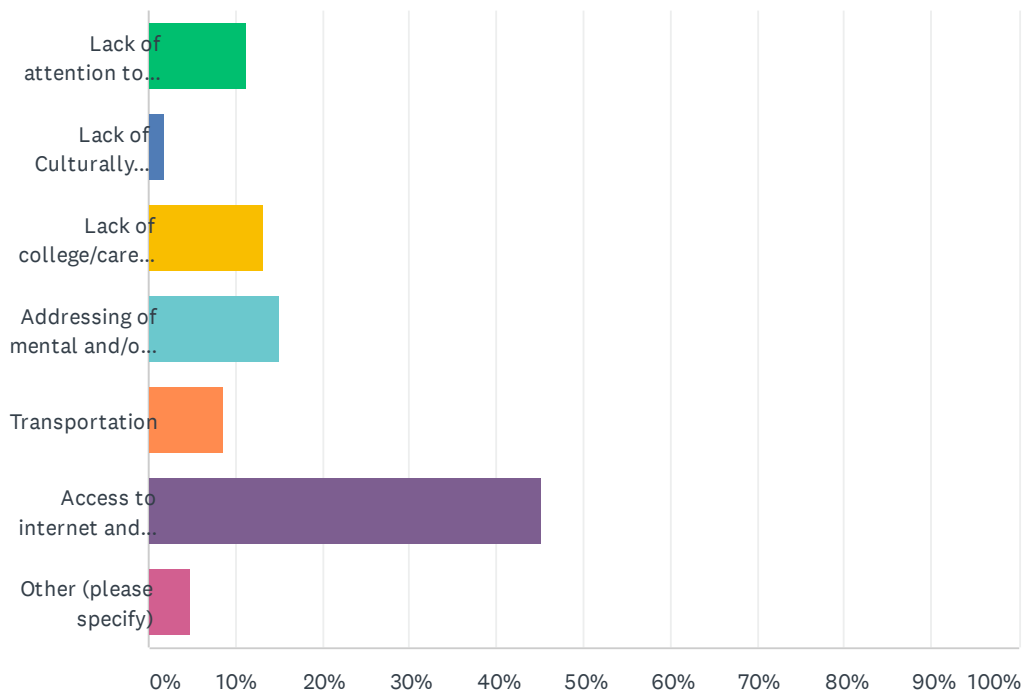

## Q10 What do you feel is a major issues that young people face in your community that might keep them from succeeding in school?

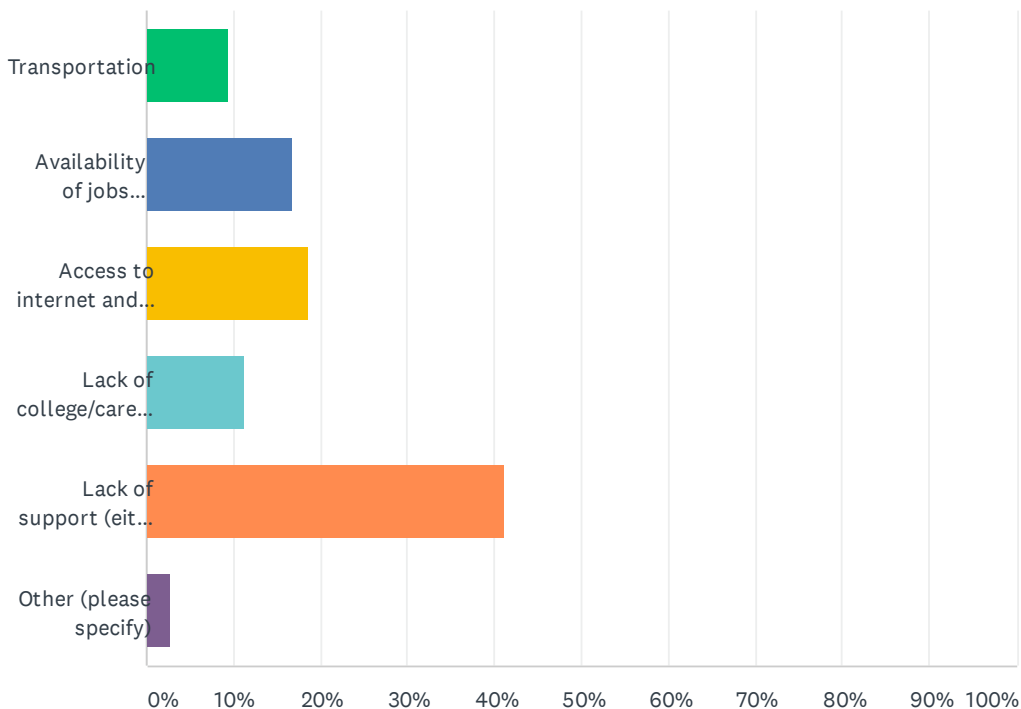

### Q11 What do you feel is a major issues that young people face in your community that might keep them from succeeding after high school?

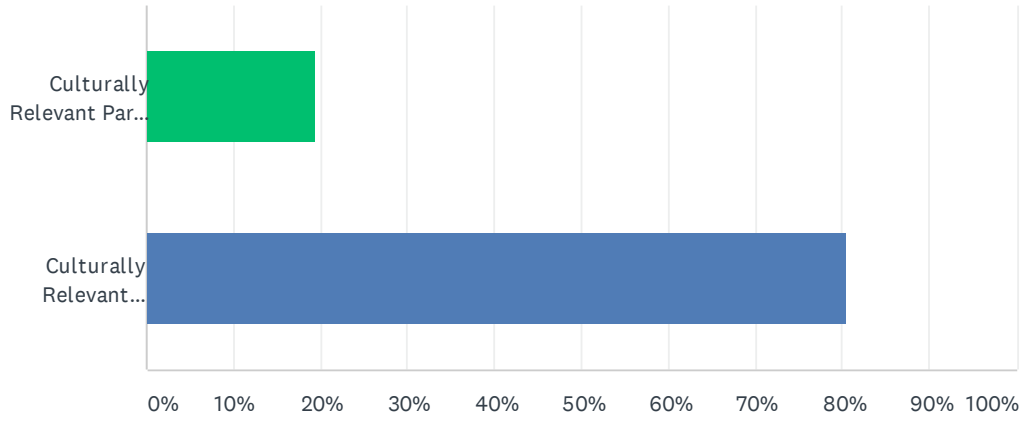

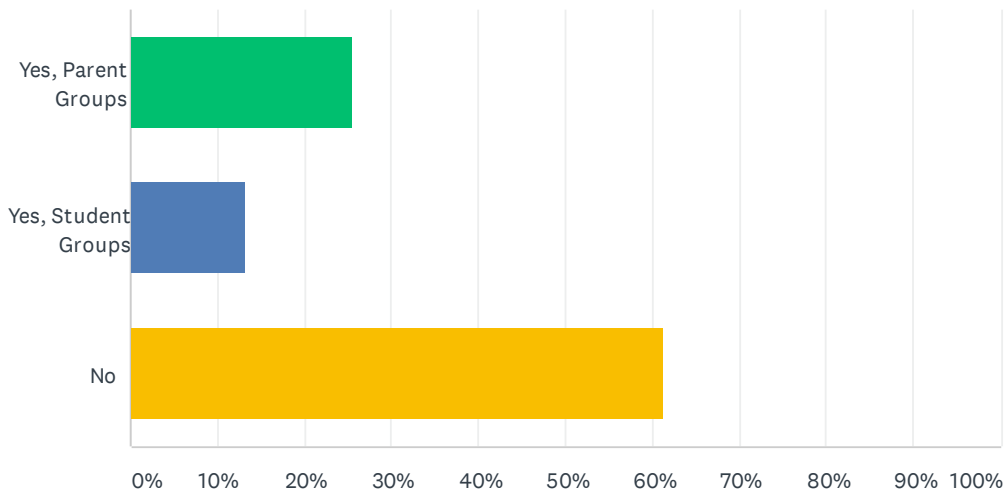

### Q13 If so, would you be interested in participating in these groups?

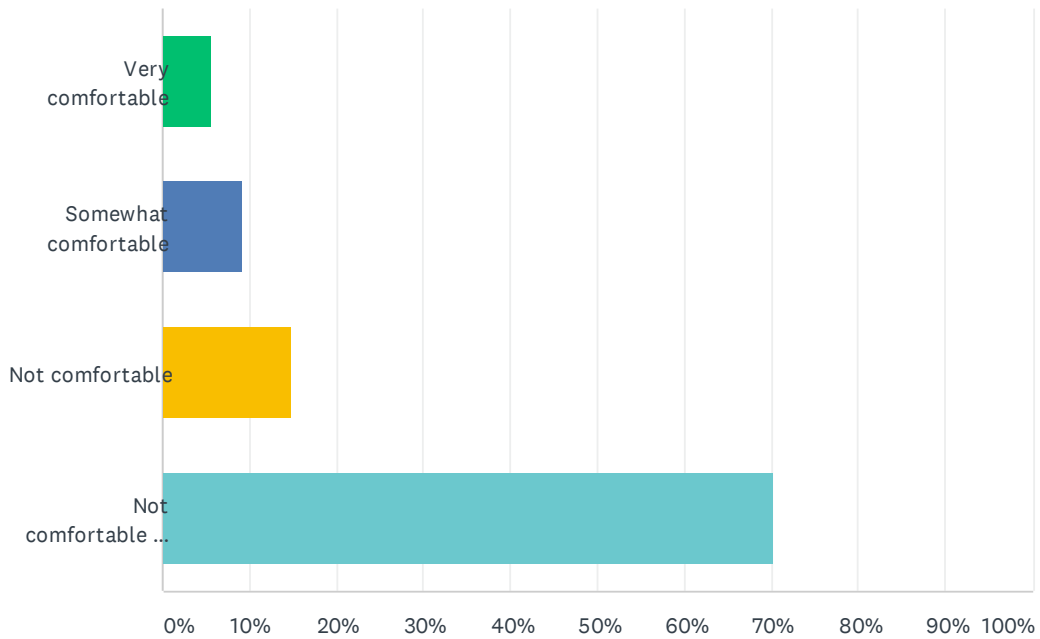

## Q14 During COVID-19, how comfortable are you sending your child back to school?

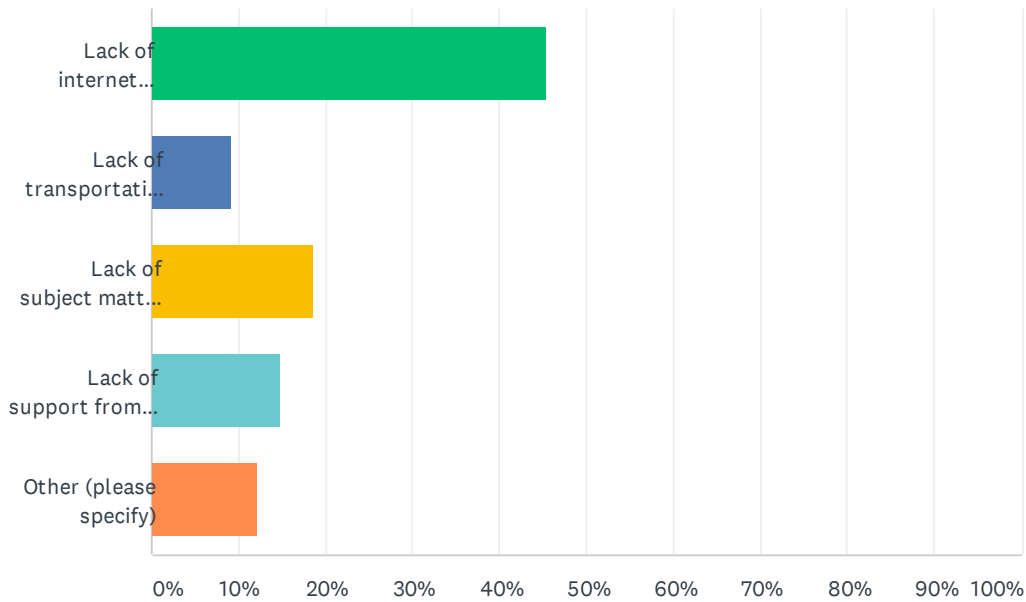

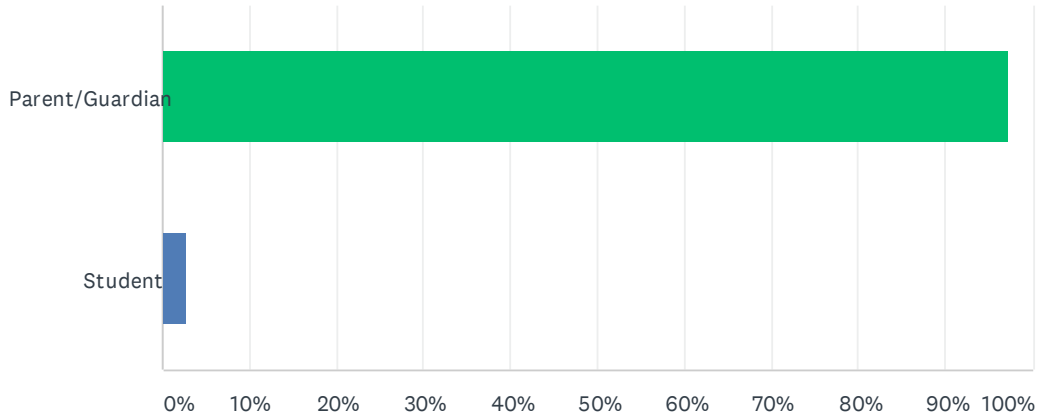
