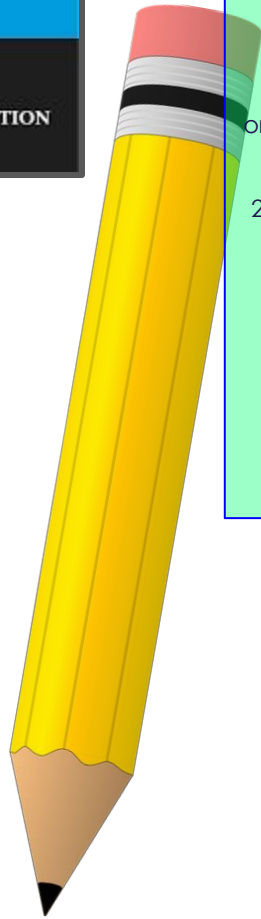

12th graders have the opportunity to take the SAT for free (!!) on October 14th and/or October 27th, since you did not get to take it last Spring because of Covid-19 school closures. You do not have to take it to graduate, but you may want to for these reasons:

1. Many colleges and universities require test scores (either the SAT or ACT) in order to enroll. Some colleges and universities are now waiving that requirement since many seniors did not test due to Covid-19 cancellations.
2. Many scholarships also require test scores (either the ACT or SAT) to qualify for financial awards. Some do not, but it's better to take the test in case you need the scores, than miss it and later wish you would have done it.
