- H) Looking towards the future, how do you see your activities as "forward looking?" What does "forward looking" mean to you?
- I) What change do you seek to foster in the world via your volunteer activities?
- J) If you were to come back in ten, twenty, or even thirty, years do you think your volunteer activities would have "made a difference?" How so?
